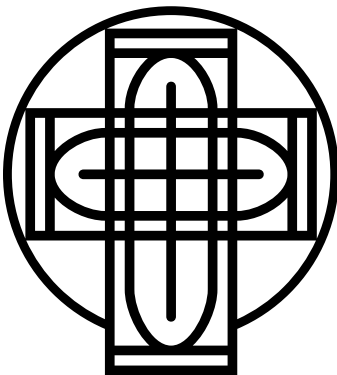
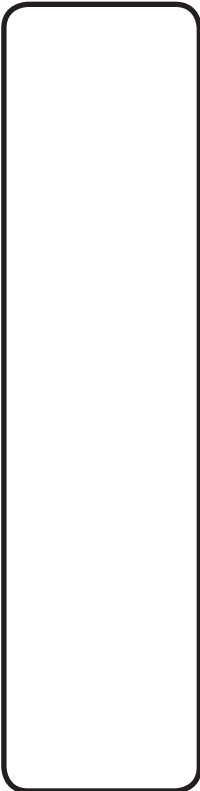

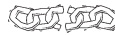


Picturing the *Lord's Supper*

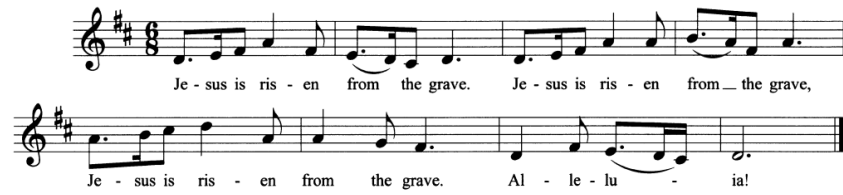
