March in the Food Pantry

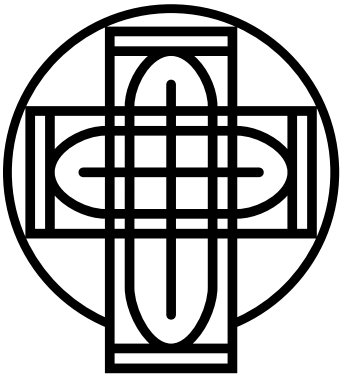
