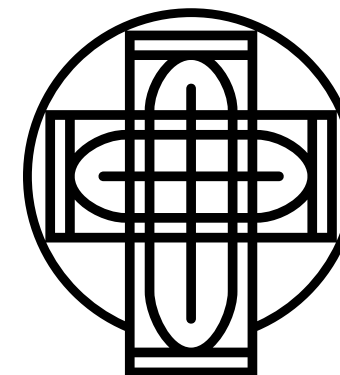

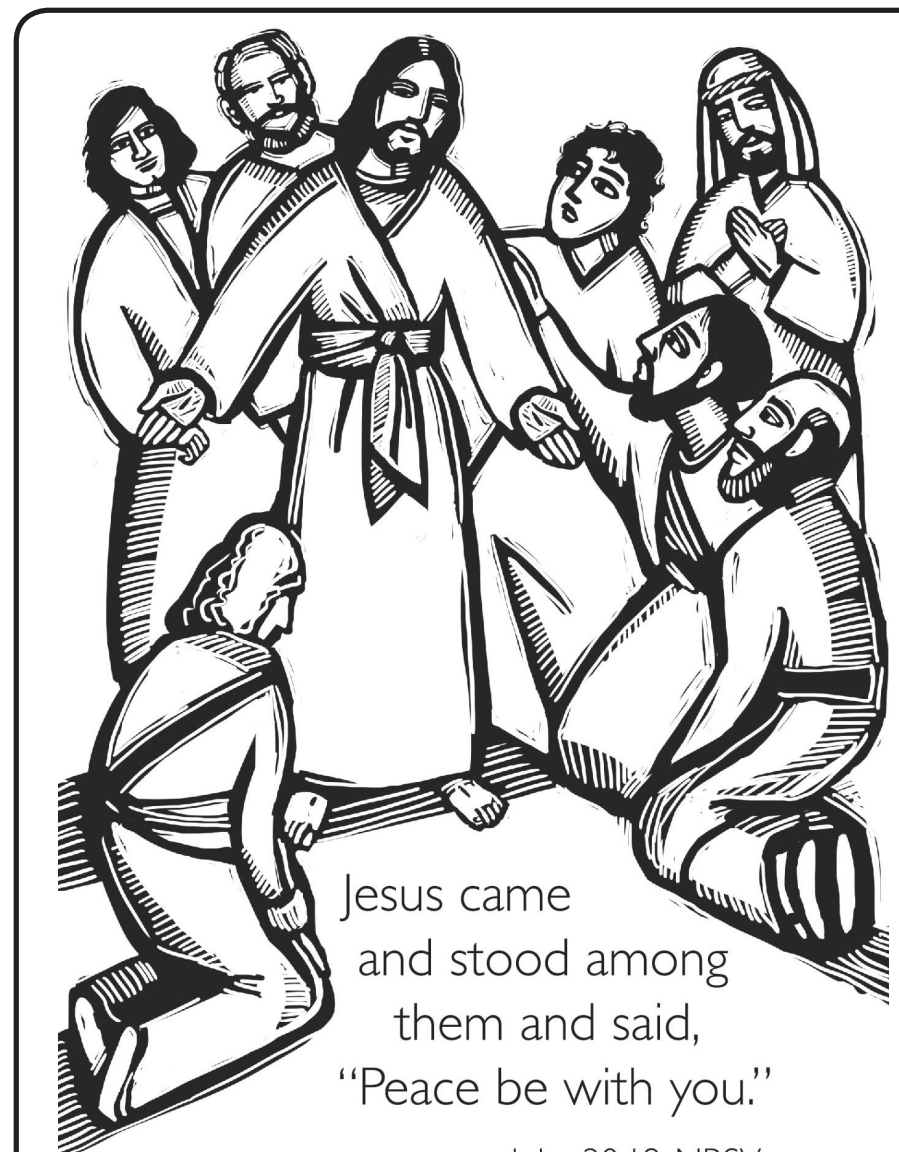

Thy praise and glory shall not fail throughout eternity.*

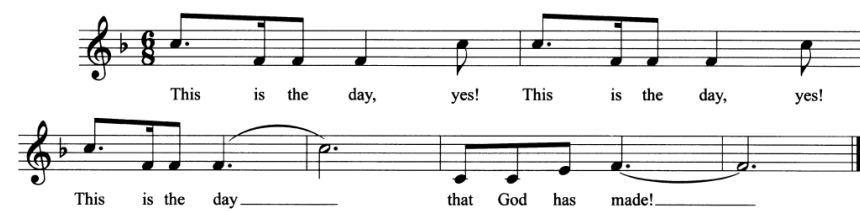

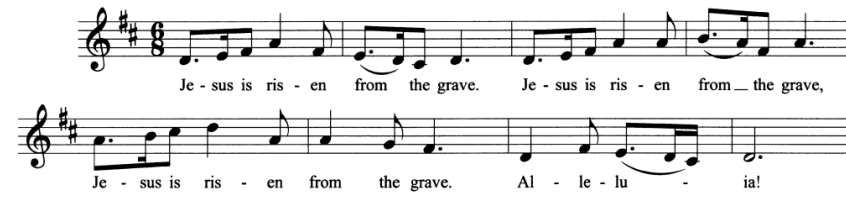
