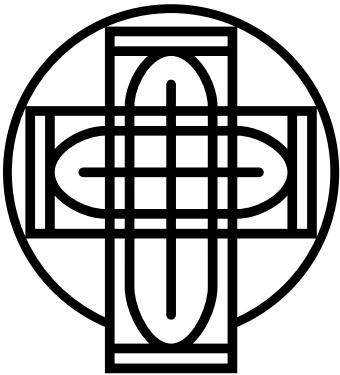

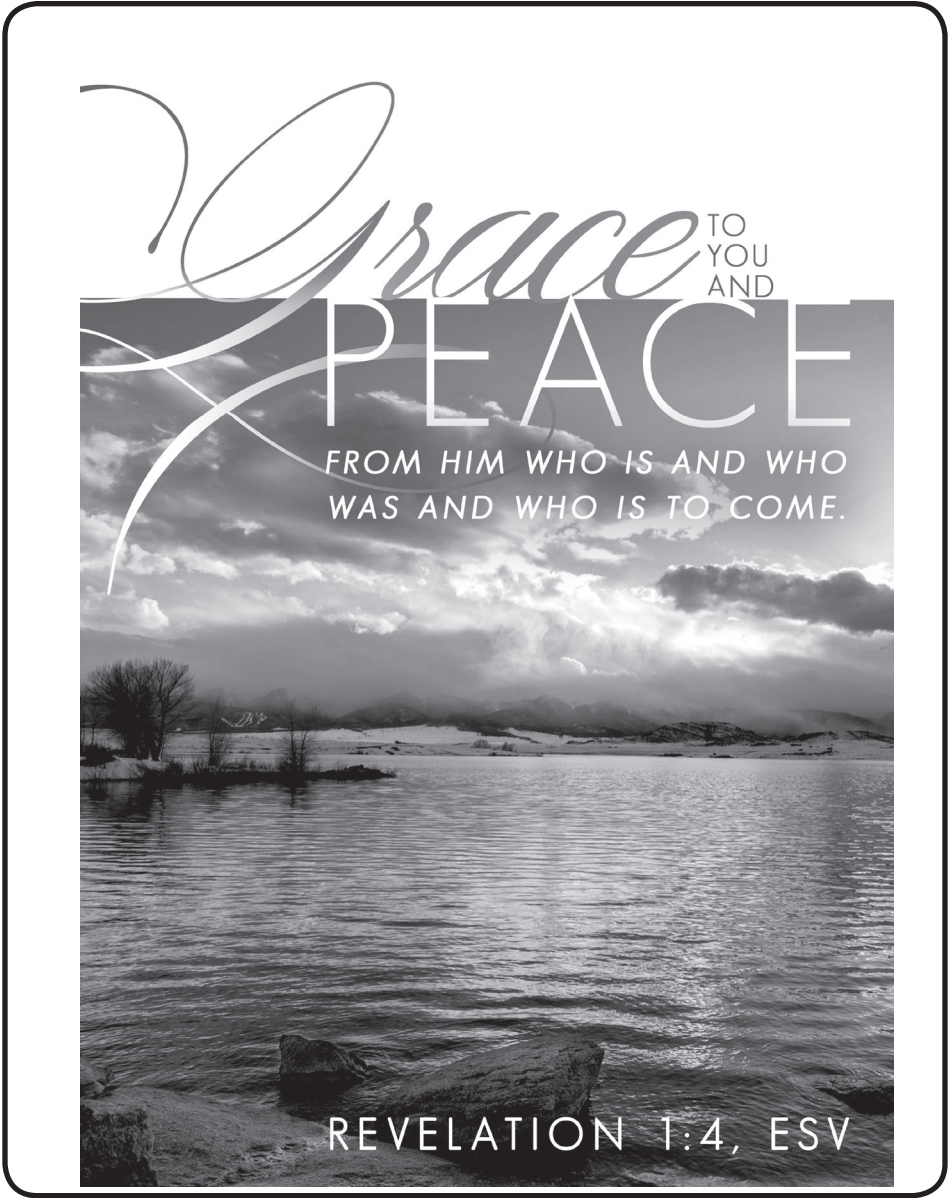
Graduate recognition!
