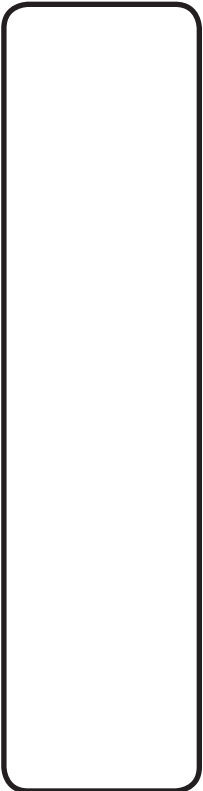

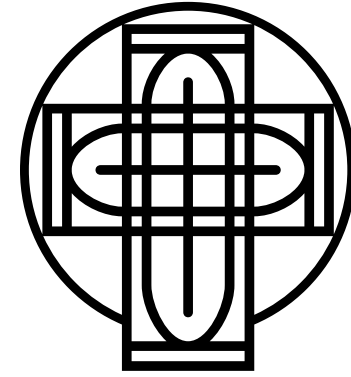


SURPRISE Birthday Parade for Anna Litteral
