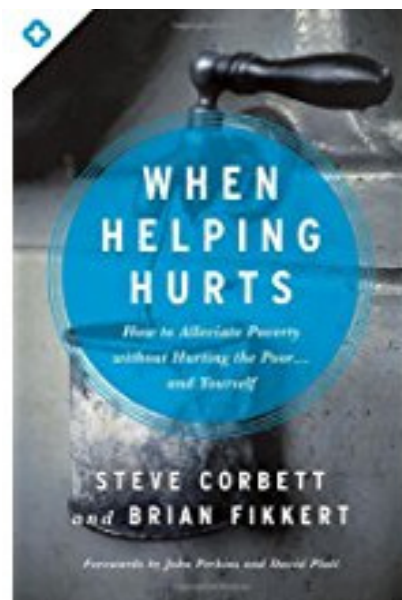


Youth Passport Trip Update:
