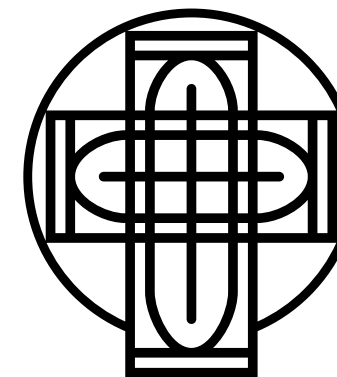

There are no adequate words to describe how beautiful it was to have people worshipping, in person, with us on Sunday morning. Granted, there were only 15 of us, so it didn't feel quite the same, but after four months without in-person worshipers, it was truly special. This small gathering also proved to help us better understand how to host small groups for worship.

Looking ahead, we must resist the temptation to rush back into opening the church because of how much we enjoyed seeing people. Our number one priority, at all times, must be the health and well-being of you, our congregation. In keeping with this priority and our desire to worship together, we are making available a sign up form to attend worship. You can find this form here: www.corbinfbc.org/registration

There are six Sundays to choose from, and we ask that you would only sign up for one in this six-week cycle. Something you should consider is are there others you would like to be physically present with on your Sunday? If so, reach out to them and choose the best Sunday for all of you. If you do not have internet access or if you have any questions, please call the church office for assistance.

On the Sundays you worship, there will be "Seat Available" signs that have been measured and placed at a safe distance from any nearby worshiper. Your worship bulletin will already be provided at the seat. We ask that you would wear a mask for the duration of the service, and that you would refrain from singing as the space between available seats does not account for safe singing distance.

We know this is all a bit strange and that we still have much farther to go, but this is a good, meaningful step. We hope you will sign up and come worship with us sometime soon. If all goes according to plan, we will continue rotational cycles like this six-week one until we can safely do more. As we continue being church, let us always be mindful of all that we can be thankful for. I am thankful to God for the ways we are able to worship. ~Alex
