Dear family and friends of F.B.C.,

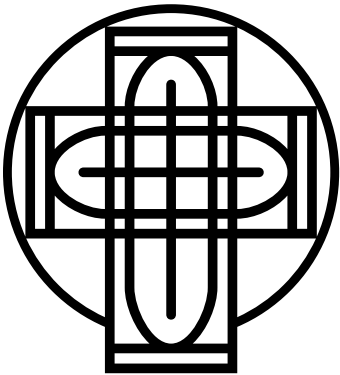
The Church Council has formed a History Committee that has

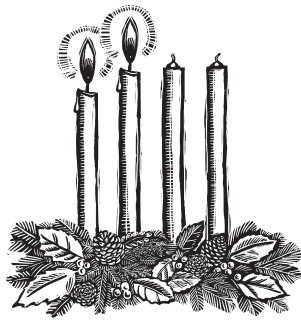

This week we are kicking off our "Winter Relief Ministry," an exciting and important new ministry that will provide shelter for the homeless on nights when the weather will drop below 29 degrees. On these nights we will, through a partnership with Knights Inn, share room vouchers—administered on a first come, first served basis—with four individuals and/or families who otherwise would be exposed to the cold. Check-in will be at 5PM in the Family Life Center, and soup will be served before guests are taken by van to the Knights Inn.

In order to sustain this ministry, we greatly appreciate any financial contribution you feel led to give. Meanwhile, we covet volunteers who are willing to help with kitchen needs (warming up and serving pre-prepared soup), with check-in (taking guest names and cross-referencing to make sure the guest in question has not previously run afoul of our published policies), and with van transport (driving or riding). If you are willing to help in any of these ways, please call the church office and let Pamela know.

As always, I and the ministerial staff remain enormously grateful for the spirit of generosity that typifies this church. Here's hoping that, through this new ministry, we can demonstrate the spirit of Christ this winter to some of those who will be most affected by the coming cold.
