



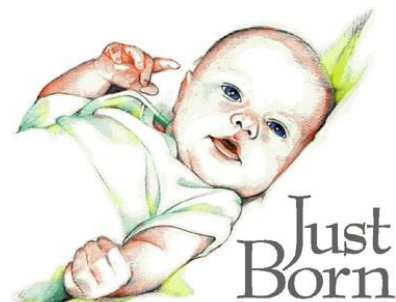

Gingerbread House Kit Drive

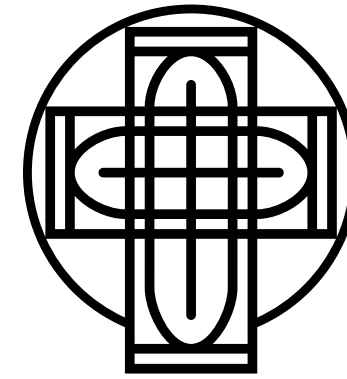

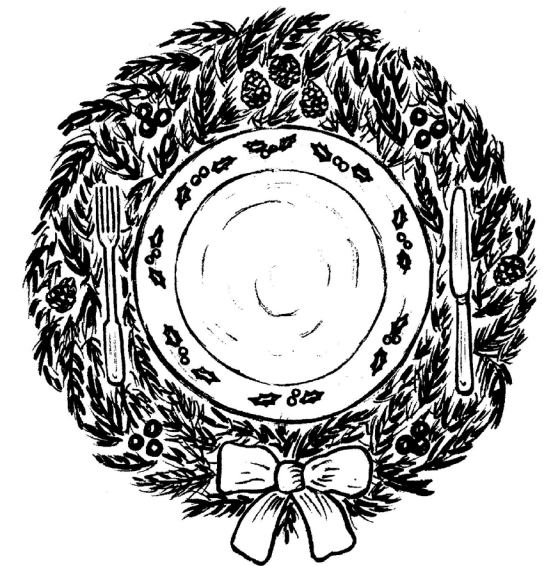
