

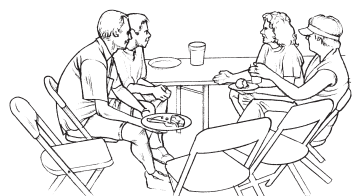


Dear Church,

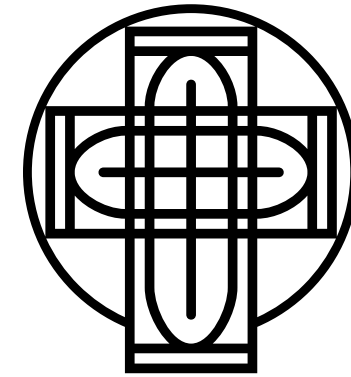
In the month of January 2019, our food pantry distributed 4,683 pounds of food to 128 households comprising 197 people?

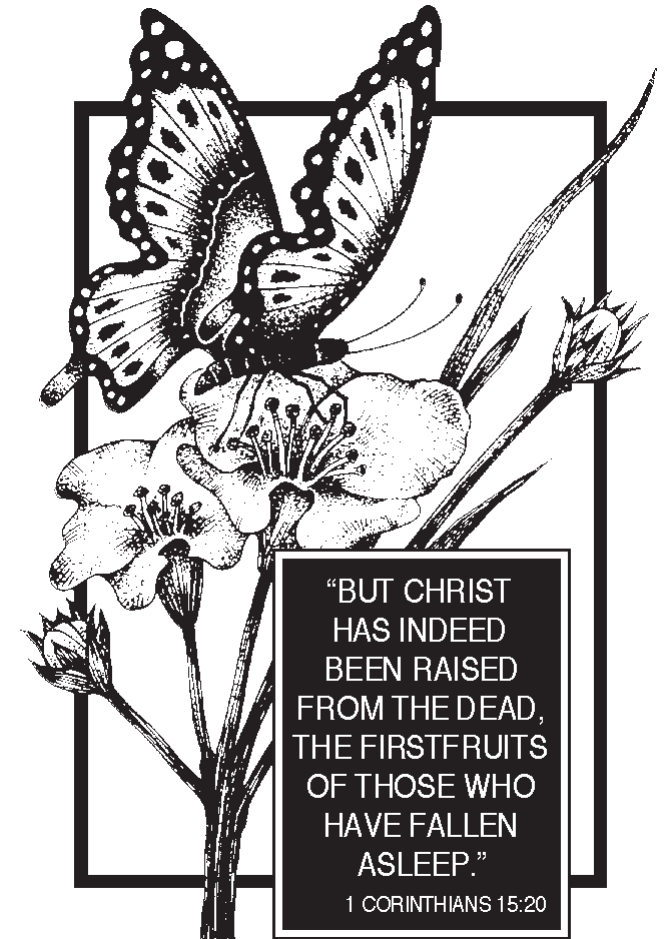

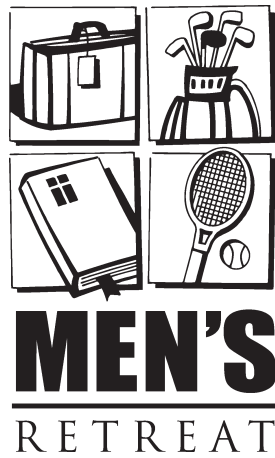
