Maxine VonGruenigen was a lifelong member of First Baptist Church. Born in Corbin in January 1930, she became a well-known member of the community at an early age. She went to work with her aunt at Maggie J's Dress Shop when she was only 15 years old, and for 73 years, until her retirement at 88, she was a bright spot in Downtown Corbin. Over the years, she played an integral role in the development of Main Street events like Octoberfest and Christmas Open House. She loved being a part of the annual Nibroc festival, especially the parade where she was known for taking her antique car through the line multiple times.

It wasn't her success in business or accomplishments in the community that Maxine is best remembered for, but rather her genuine love for her family, friends, and this church. You rarely saw her that she didn't have a story to tell about the family she shared with Eldred. Her son, Eddie Lee, and two grandsons, Casey and Chad, were her pride and joy. She was always an encourager and supporter for the people she cared about. She sent cards and her signature smiley face mums to people almost daily just to let them know she was thinking of them. She was so proud of her church and the many different missions of the church. She loved her Sunday School class, and looked forward to the annual Sunday School Christmas party she hosted. She would have so much fun retelling stories from the games of Christmas Bingo and White Elephant gift exchanges at the party.

Maxine was a true example of Christian hospitality. She loved to gather people together to laugh and have a good time, sometimes with a costume involved. She always had a kind and uplifting word to share. You never left her presence without feeling better for having been with her. That is why she is one of our Stained Glass Saints.
