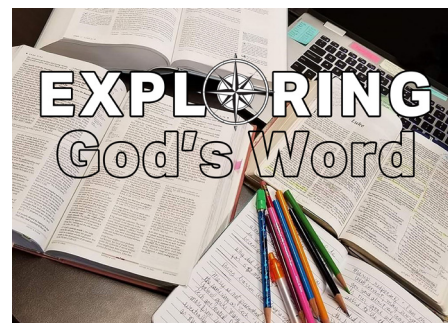

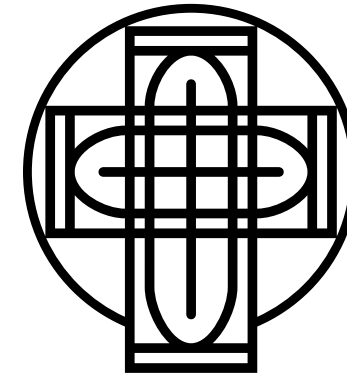

That love and peace and justice may give God's kingdom birth.*

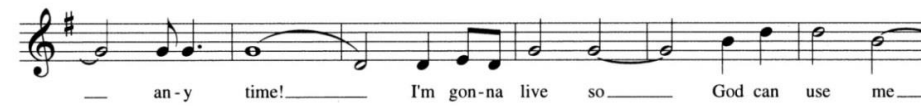
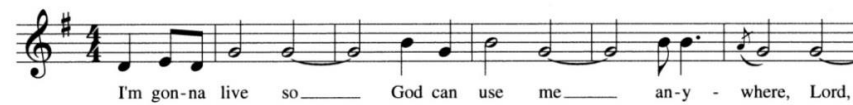
