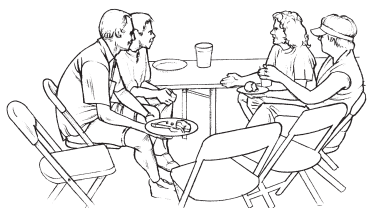

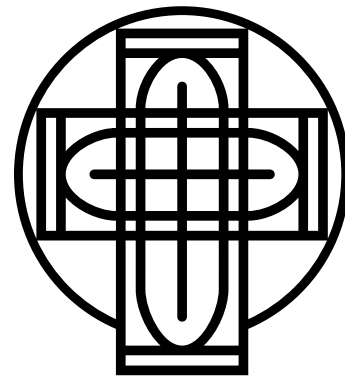

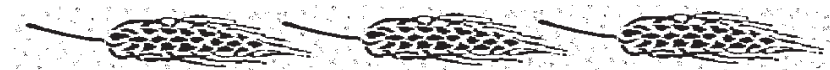
At the FBC Food Pantry in December 2016, 112 families, which included approximately 220 individuals, were served on the four Thursdays they were open.
