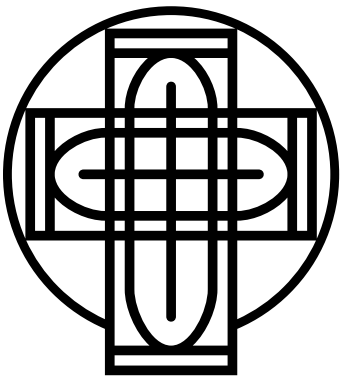

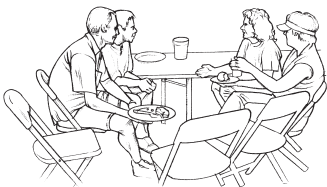
This is CPR only and does not include First Aid.
