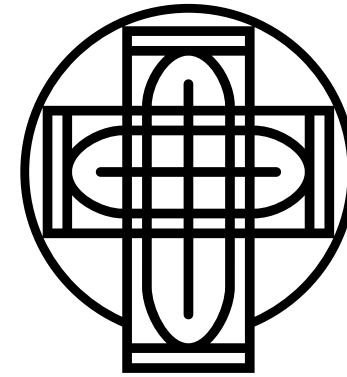

Kids and Youth In Action -

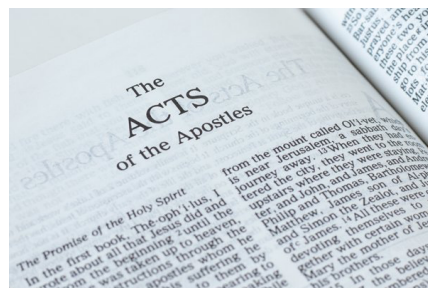
3rd-5th Grade Quarterly Class- During service Sunday:
