

Wednesday's New Look

In this new year, we have re-envisioned our Wednesday night ministries and offerings. It is an ongoing re-envisioning process, but there is good energy behind it and many faithful people who will see it through. I write this to encourage you to invest in this ministry. We have a new start time of 6:00. This helps those who work until 5:00 or so, and it will give student volunteers more time to prepare activities and receive students.

One big change is how we provide food for those who attend. Children will get pizza every Wed., and they will always eat for free. Beginning in February, the adults will utilize a rotation that goes like this: 1st Wednesday: Bring your own meal (No cost) 2nd Wednesday: Pizza (\$6 per adult) 3rd Wednesday: Potluck (casseroles recommended-No cost) 4th Wednesday: Kitchen crew provides (\$8 per adult)

The children's ministry has revamped its programming, leaning on 15 minute stations that will keep the children moving and engaged, each station emphasizing fun, creativity, and biblical story. We have a few new volunteers to help with the stations and van driving, but there is always opportunity for you to get involved. Reach out to Jeremiah if you feel led to this vital ministry.

The adults will continue our Revelation study. We will begin in prayer, as we have always done, but we will combine our prayer/study time with the meal for time's sake. If you've never participated in our adult Bible study, it is a very conversation based approach to Scripture and study. Questions are encouraged, doubts are allowed, and we discover the deep mysteries of our faith together. It is never too late to jump in!

God is faithful. God has always been faithful and will always be faithful. We are making changes, but we cling to the One who never changes. We have faith that God will see this through, and we believe the Spirit is working among us. We invite you to participate. These gatherings are good for the soul. Just ask anyone who participates.
