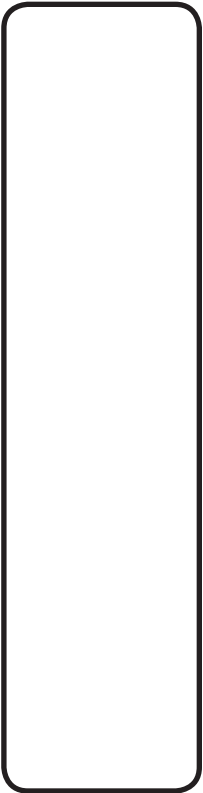

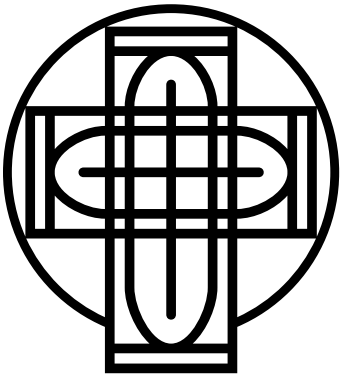


In Case of Inclement Weather . . .

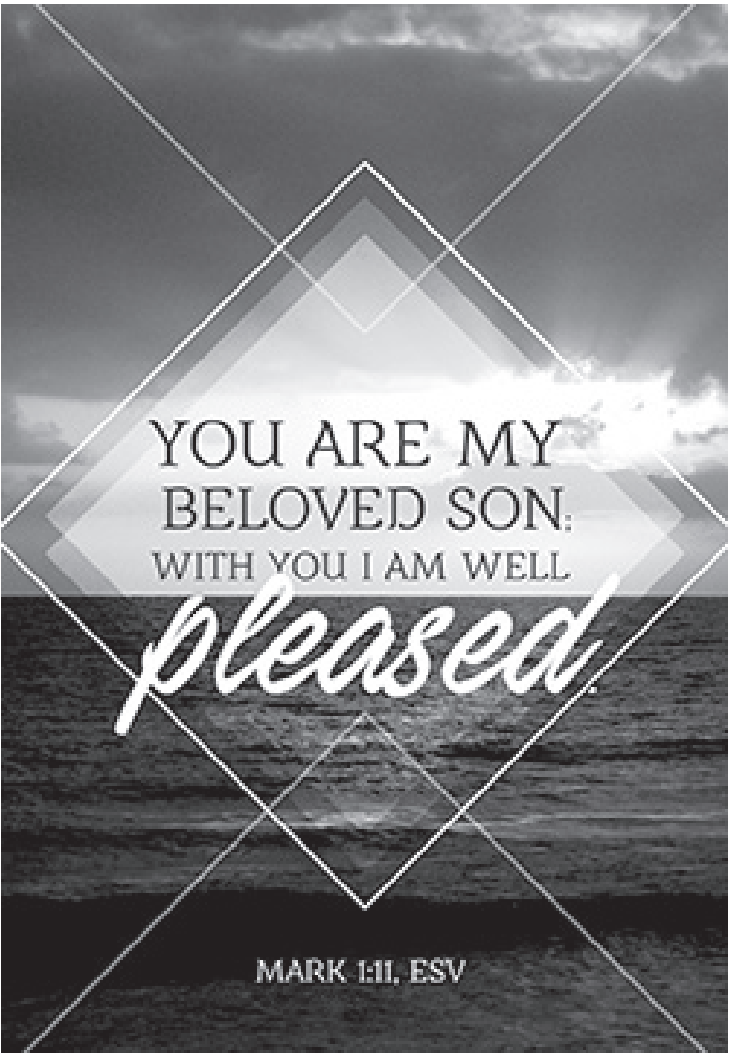

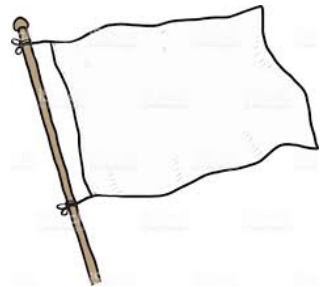
