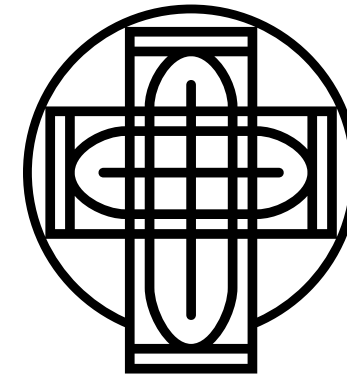

## **June 22 Business Meeting Recap**

Conducting the business of the church in an orderly and transparent manner is essential to any thriving congregation. This recap is to keep you abreast of all the happenings at our church. In doing so, my hope is this will motivate you to play your part in the business of the church. We need you to pray for our initiatives, participate in them, and support them as you see fit. Church business is meaningless without the participation of the congregation.

The first item of business that required a vote was presented by the ad hoc Children's Facilities Committee. This committee was appointed by the Church Council to evaluate our facilities related to our children and to offer proposals to the church to improve those spaces.

After exploring how other churches have chosen to construct their children's spaces and after surveying the young families of this church, the committee proposed we build a new playground where our existing one is. After a lengthy but fruitful conversation, the proposal was accepted by the church. Accounting for shipping and other standard delays, we hope to begin the installation of the new playground in 12-14 weeks.

This "yes" vote is a sign of a healthy church that desires to grow. We have put our collective money where our mouth is in terms of investing in young people. Immediately, this playground will benefit our families and young people with the opportunity for creative playtime during our regularly scheduled programming. It will also offer our families a safe alternative to outdoor recreation throughout the week. Long-term, my hope is the Corbin community will see that First Baptist Church cares about young families.

The other items of business that required a vote included a thorough revision to our Personnel Policy Manual, confirmation of our Nominating Committee and Deacon Nominating Committee slates, and a \$1500 donation to be sent to St. Paul Baptist Church in Barboursville as part of a community effort to replace their roof. All items passed.

As always, all information regarding the church's business is available in the office. Should you have any questions or concerns, please reach out. Business meetings may not be glamorous, but they are vital for congregations that wish to live out the call of Jesus Christ in the world today. Thank you for cultivating a community that allows for good business, and may we continue doing the good business of God's Kingdom.
