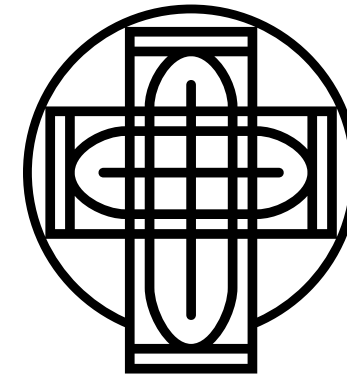


Save Your Items for Our Rummage Sale
