

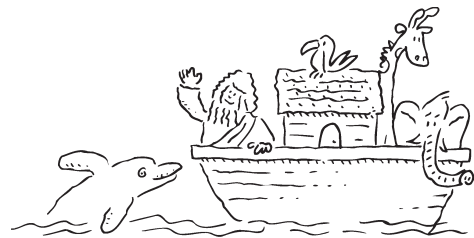


The Annual NIBROC Rummage Sale – August 11-13

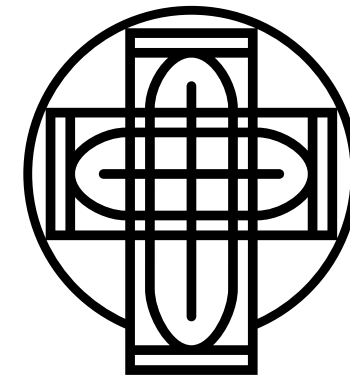
