

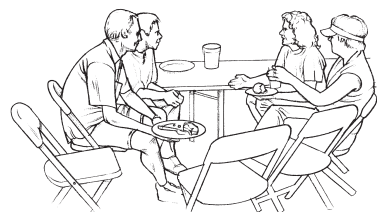


The Annual NIBROC Rummage Sale – August 10-12

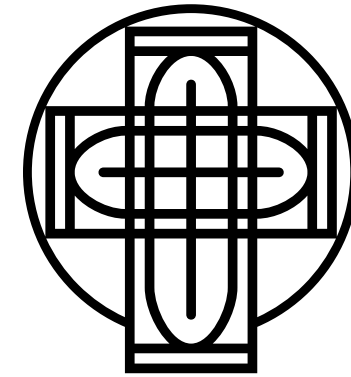

After several years of attending an annual missions conference in Louisville, Laura has felt this as her calling. She has met several of the workers from Togo and is excited to begin her service. She will leave her Louisville home on August 1 to begin work in Mango, Togo, at Hopital de l'Esperance, sponsored by the Association of Baptists for World Evangelism organization. The facility, which has about 70 healthcare workers, provides room and board, so she'll have basic necessities.

Although she has been a member and a Sunday School teacher at Kenwood Baptist Church in Louisville for a long time, Laura still feels a kinship with First Baptist. It was here where she began her Christian life, becoming active in youth activities and serving as Children's Minister for over a year. Our congregation supported her when she went to Ethiopia as a summer missionary years ago.
