It's that time of the year again- Vacation Bible School is back! Tuesday, July 26th to Friday, July 29th from 6-8:30 pm daily, we will be hosting Vacation Bible School. Our theme this year is "ON THE CASE", where children will journey together as detectives INVESTIGATING the mystery of God's great love for us!

Each evening we will have a full dinner, group worship, and fun activities as well as a parable of Jesus that we will use as a key CLUE to help us investigate this mystery. Beginning with Day 1, we will investigate the Parable of the Sower to find out how we can grow in our relationship with God. 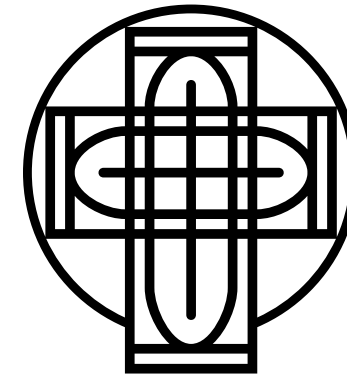
