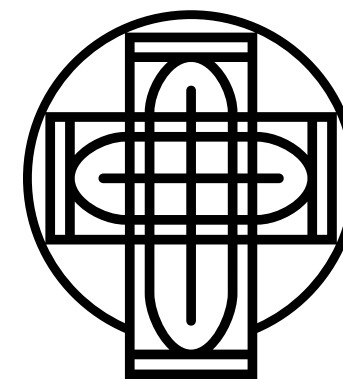

According to the FBC By-Laws, the "Search Committee shall be composed of seven (7) members, one of whom shall be an active deacon, and each of whom shall be a member of the church and not a paid staff member". Collectively, the Ministerial Search Committee should represent our congregation.

To volunteer or to nominate a church member to serve on the Ministerial Search Committee, please submit names to the church office over the next two weeks – by phone, email, or in person. Also, feel free to speak directly with any of the Church Council members.

The slate of nominees for the Ministerial Search Committee will be compiled at the next Church Council meeting on Thursday, July 18. This slate will then be presented to the church membership for vote at the next regularly scheduled business meeting, which will be held Wednesday, July 24, here at the church.

After that business meeting vote, the Ministerial Search Committee will begin the process of advertising the position and recruiting, screening, and interviewing applicants. Once selected by the Ministerial Search Committee, the candidate will be recommended to the membership at a business meeting for a vote.

Thank you in advance for helping the Church Council with this important responsibility of identifying the Ministerial Search Committee.
