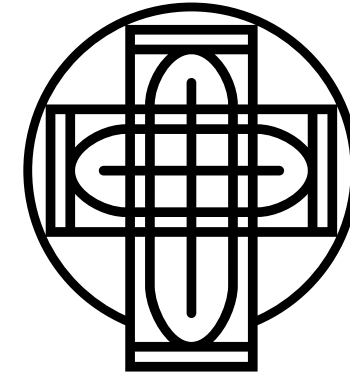

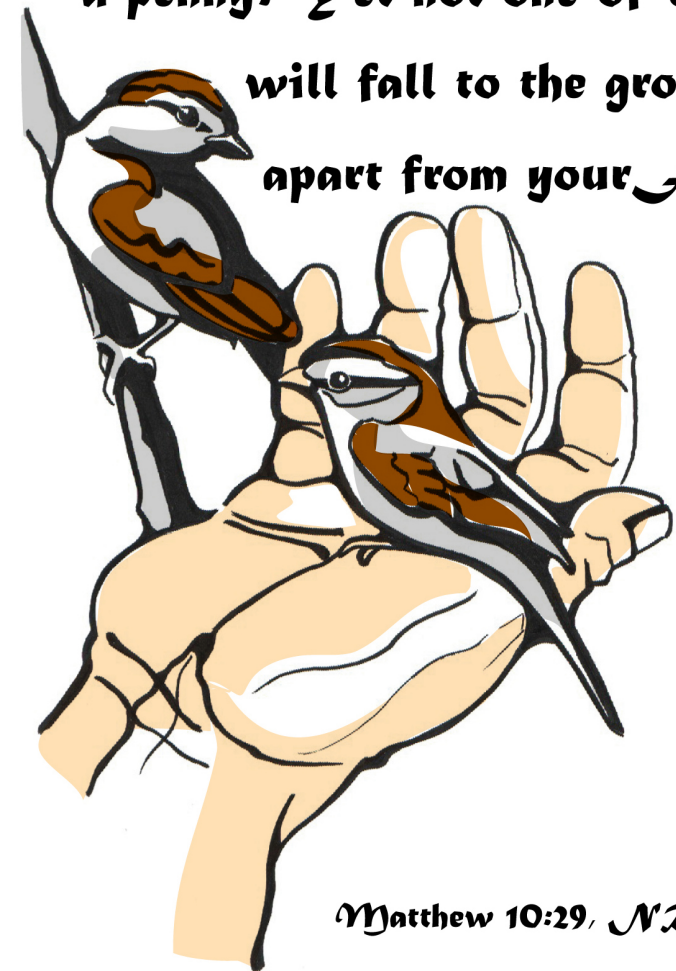

To God all praise and glory.*

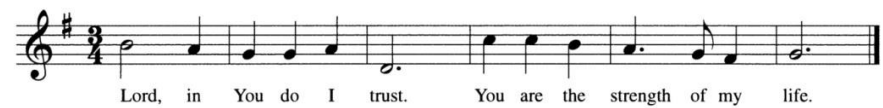
*The Lord is never far away, but through all grief distressing,
