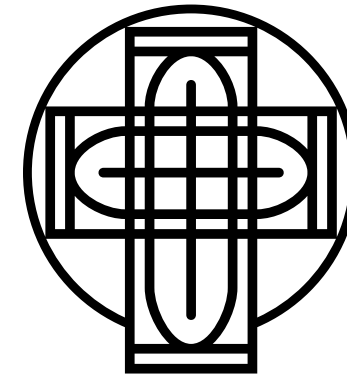

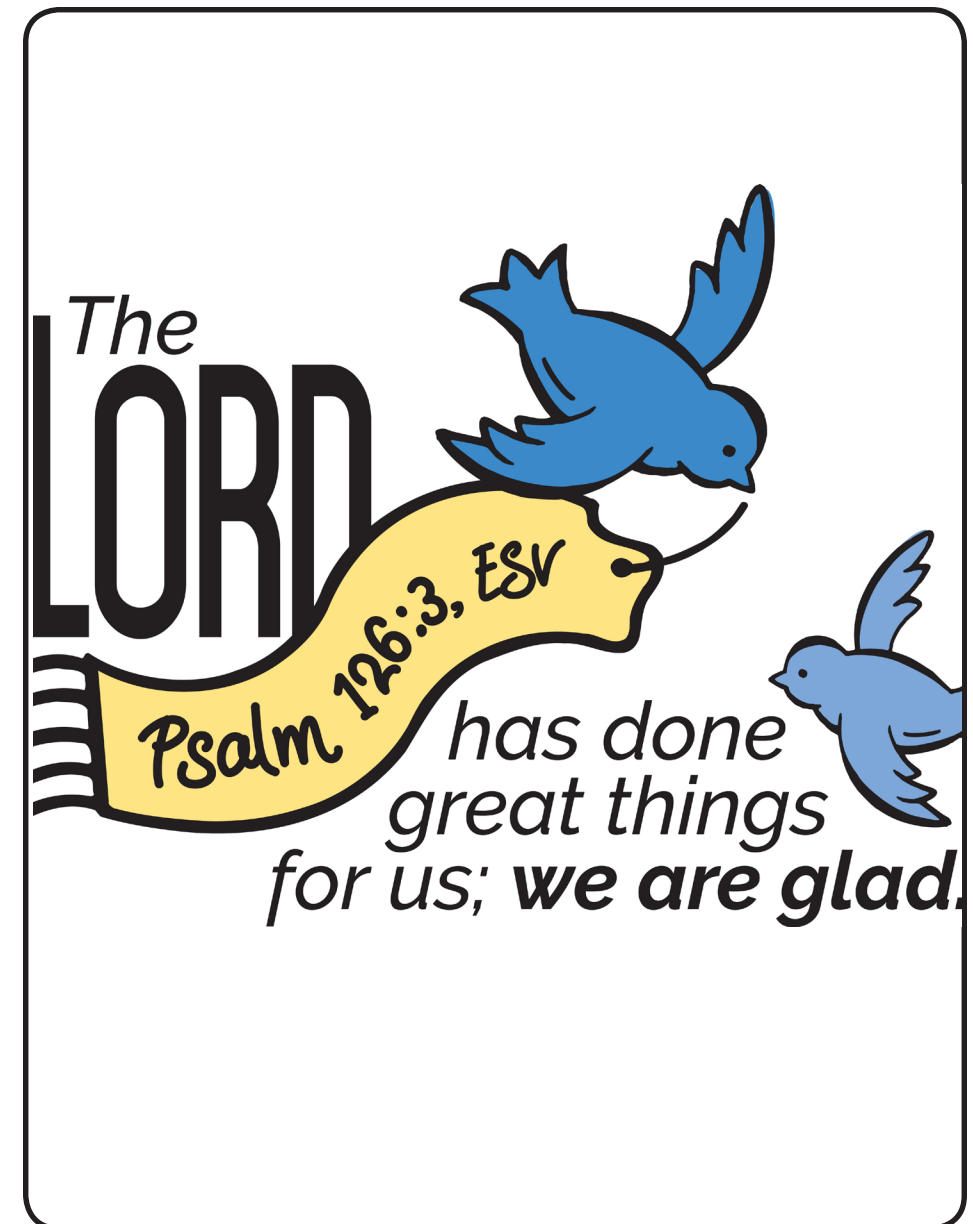

At First Baptist Church, there are many ways to get involved and to utilize the gifts and passions God has given you for the sake of the Kingdom. Some of these methods are often overlooked, like the bereavement ministry. We have a team of several bereavement meal leaders who respond, as a ministry of our church, to those who have recently suffered loss.

When someone connected to the church passes away, one of these leaders will make contact with the bereaved and offer a homemade meal to be delivered to the home so that the family can have one less complication during their most difficult days of grief. As you can imagine, this requires the help of many. Several dishes of food are required for each meal. We also need monetary donations to cover the cost of certain foods we are unable to make at home.

These are ways you can do the good and important ministry of care and sympathy within our congregation. You can volunteer to contribute food or funds by joining one of our bereavement meal teams. Once included on a team, you are given the opportunity on a rotational basis to care for our grieving siblings in Christ. If you feel you are unable to join a team at this time, there is another way you can contribute to this ministry: the Bereavement Fund. On occasion, our meal teams utilize the Bereavement Fund to offset the costs of providing meals. Your donations to this fund can help sustain this ministry for many years to come.

As you pray and consider how God might use you at our church, remember to give thanks for those who respond to grief with God's love and a warm meal. We are more effectively Christ's presence because of the many people who serve on and lead our bereavement teams. Also remember to pray for and support those who continue to grieve, for the loss of a loved one is not something one ever moves on from. May God continue the good work of our bereavement ministry, and may it be through us.
