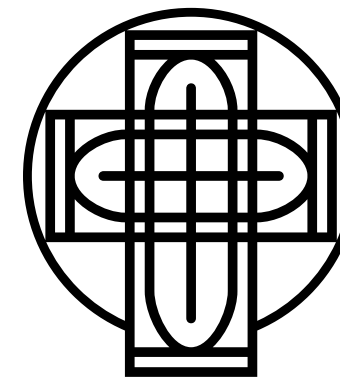

These past few Sundays have been exhilarating! Personally, seeing people back in our sacred space has rejuvenated my soul. Yes, we still have a long way to go, but, as a faithful community of God's people, we are making progress. I am grateful for all of you, for your prayers and patience, and for your faithfulness.

Continuing to move forward, I would like to, as a reminder, mention that the cutoff time for registering for worship is noon on Fridays. If you register after noon, we are unlikely to receive your registration. Once confirmed for worship, you should receive an email explaining our health guidelines. One significant request we have of all attendees is to arrive by 10:15 so that we can seat everyone safely.

As for Holy Week, we will have a virtual noon service on each day, Monday through Friday. We will, also, have a Good Friday Tenebrae service at 7:30 pm. This is both virtual and in-person, so please register if you plan to attend in-person. Lastly, we will have three identical Easter morning services with start times at 8:30, 10:00, and 11:30. The 10:00 o'clock service will be our virtual service for those who wish to worship at home. Please register for the Easter service you prefer.

Many Sunday school classes are getting back together, and this brings me great delight. Please check with your Sunday school teacher/leader about what your class is offering. On Easter morning, we will not have Sunday school, but we will have an Easter Egg Hunt for our children after the 10:00 and 11:30 Easter services. If you are able, please consider donating individually-wrapped candies already placed inside plastic eggs, and drop those off at the office by Wednesday, March 31.

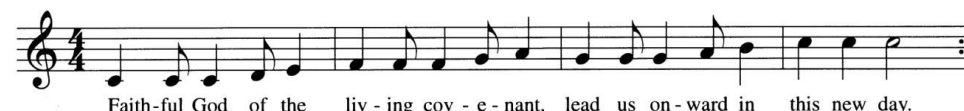
The Lord's Prayer
