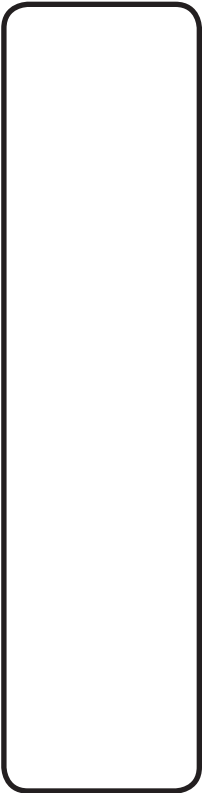

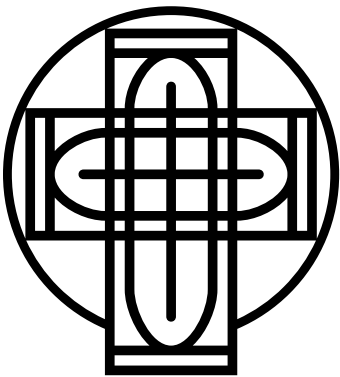

A Bible Story Retold (Inspired by the end of our White Flag Season)

When it grew late in the season, a group of disciples came together at First Baptist Church of Corbin, KY and said, "It is getting cold. Winter will soon be upon us, and many in our community have no place to go to escape the cold."

The disciples and their pastors all looked at one another concernedly, devastated by the situation but uncertain how to help.

Just then, one in their midst said, "We should give them a place to stay."

Astonished, the disciples and their pastors all said to one another, "How can we provide rooms for this many people, for this many nights? We have but a few thousand dollars—and the winter is so long, and the number in need is so many."

To which another in their midst said, "How much do we have?"

Another replied: "6,000 dollars."

So, taking that 6,000 dollars and looking up to heaven, the group of disciples and their pastors prayed over the money, blessed and broke it, and then began dividing it among those in need in the community.

By the winter's end, thanks to the generous support and selfless service of 48 different churches, businesses, and nonprofits in the local community, those disciples had provided 1553 rooms and 2205 meals to those in need, the oldest recipient being 82 years old, the youngest, 11 months.

All in need of shelter were sheltered that winter, and all in need of meals were fed. The disciples then gathered what was left of that feast in baskets, and began praying and preparing for the winter ahead.

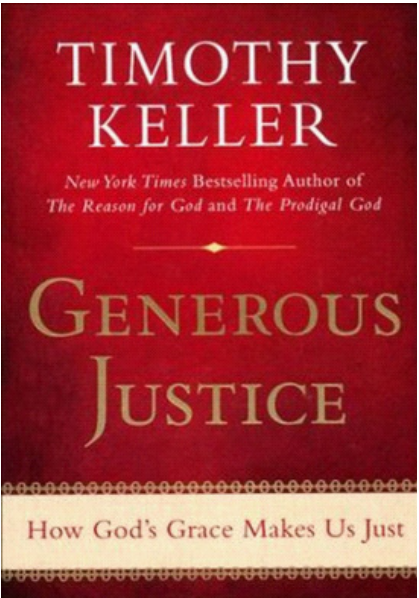
