# This Week We Remember IW Norvell

J.W. Norvell was born June 8, 1933, the first child of Newt and Ida Norvell, followed soon by sisters Mary Joyce and Glennis. The family faithfully attended their community church, Lynn Camp Baptist, which was then in very rural Knox County. He became a Christian as a very young man and was baptized in the Norvell family pond, as were many other local community members.

After serving in the US Air Force and working in the Engineering Department Experimental Lab for Cadillac in Michigan, JW returned to Corbin and attended Cumberland Junior College, which we now know as the University of the Cumberlands. He earned B.S. and M.S. degrees in Industrial Arts from Eastern Kentucky University and subsequently launched the Industrial Arts Program at Lynn Camp High School. He married Amelia Keck in December 1961, soon welcoming Mary Elizabeth and James Rodney to their family. At that time, the extended Norvell family attended Poplar Grove Baptist Church, where JW was ordained as a deacon.

When American Greeting Card Corporation opened in 1969, JW was hired and worked there nearly 30 years, retiring in May 1999 as the Senior Engineer. During this time, the Norvells began regularly attending First Baptist Church and added another son, Ryan, to the family. JW served as a deacon at FBC for almost 40 years and faithfully attended Sunday School, morning and evening worship service on Sundays, and Wednesday evening prayer meetings. He was frequently found at FBC, contributing his design and building talents to the facilities committee and performing the always-needed repair work around the church. Many brides married and others hosting receptions at FBC have used plant stands and backdrops he constructed for church events; several of which are still in use today. JW was active in the community and instrumental in the construction of Baptist Housing, serving on the first Board of Directors and for many years as secretary. In appreciation of this community achievement, he was appointed a Kentucky Colonel by Governor John Y. Brown, Jr. and recognized as an ambassador of good will. He was also a 50-year member of Cumberland Valley Masonic Lodge of Grav, Kentucky.

Don Robinson's Sunday School Class was one of the things JW enjoyed most about FBC, regularly attending and contributing to the lively discussions until he became too ill to participate. Throughout his life in so many ways, he demonstrated the fruits of the Spirit – love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control – serving as an example to his family and the broader community.
