They were good friends with John and Jayne Dunaway, and frequently visited First Baptist, Corbin, where their daughter, Elizabeth, is a member. Once they moved to Corbin, they joined this church and were members of Bob Lockhart's Sunday School class. In 2003, Andy, as well as Bob Lockhart, were named Pastors Emeritus of First Baptist, Corbin. Whenever able, Andy and Viola were here on Sundays and Wednesdays, and enjoyed the worship, fellowship, and friends here.

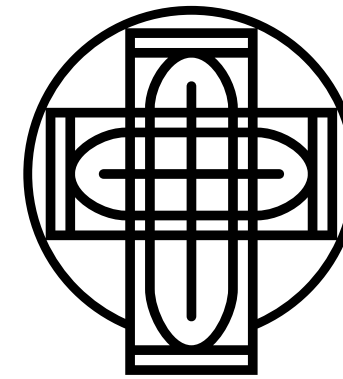
