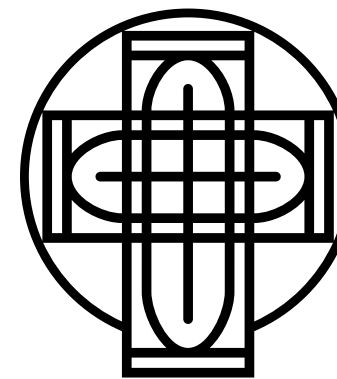
Tables of 8 is back!

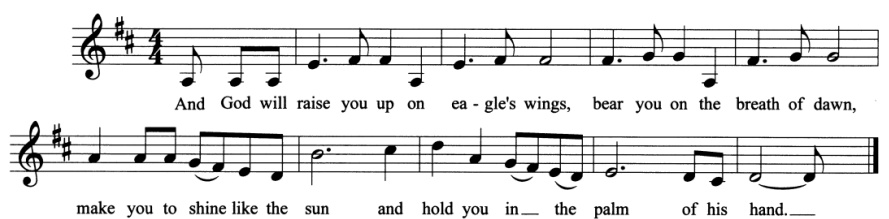
