Dear Church,

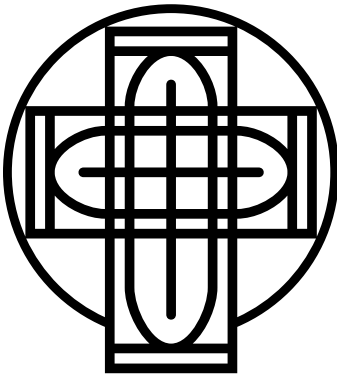
