Children's Ministry Update:

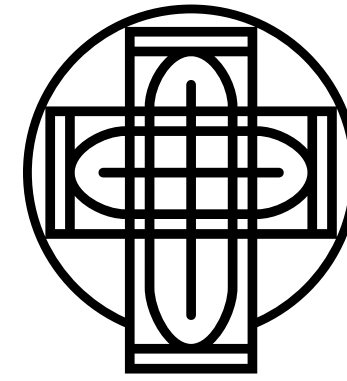

Christ is risen indeed! Alleluia!*

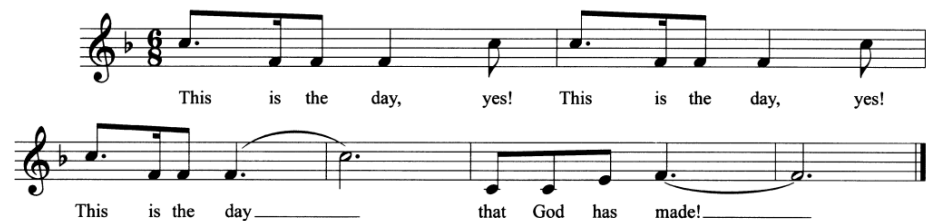
*The time has come to worship our God.
