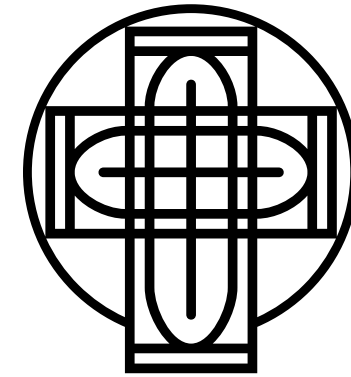
The FBC Carnegie Ministries Food Pantry distributed 5,234 pounds of food to 120 households comprising 223 people in the month of April 2019.

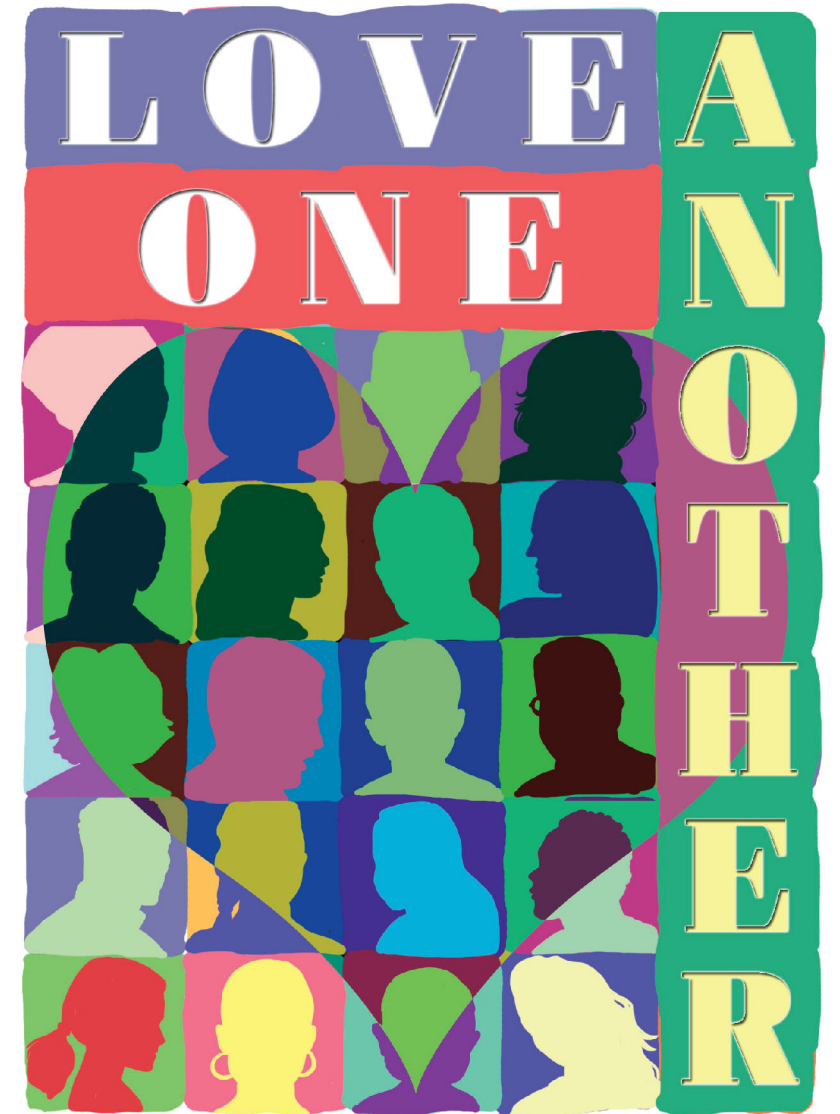
