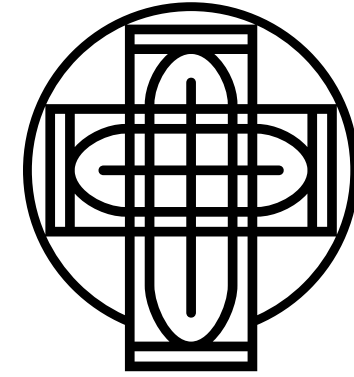

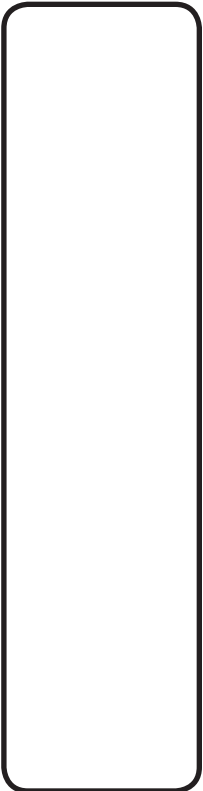

*From the Church Council*

After considering advice garnered from medical experts, epidemiologists, virologists, the church's insurance company, The Centers for Disease Control, the Office of the Governor, and the leaders of the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship, the Church Council has determined that we should continue "online only" worship and Bible study through the end of June. The council will revisit this decision mid-June to see if in-person services can resume in July.

We realize that this is disappointing news for many. We, too, had hoped that we could resume in-person services at an earlier date, but feel that it is in the best interest of the membership to continue our present course of operation.

What we are doing now is working, and though it will not work in perpetuity, it allows us time to make good and well-reasoned decisions for the church body.

We are grateful to our worship leaders - the preachers, musicians, and technicians - who have made it possible for us to be together virtually in worship and Bible study. And we are thankful for your participation in these services and for your continued support of the church through your offerings.

We recognize that the work of the church continues - through ministries like Baptist Housing, the Food Pantry, The Mustard Seed Garden, and The White Flag Ministry. We also acknowledge the many ways - large and small - that you are **being** church to one another and to our community.

Please know that we pray for you - and we look forward to the day when we can gather together in the same place to share Christ's peace and to sing God's praises.

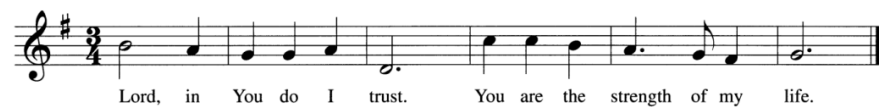
