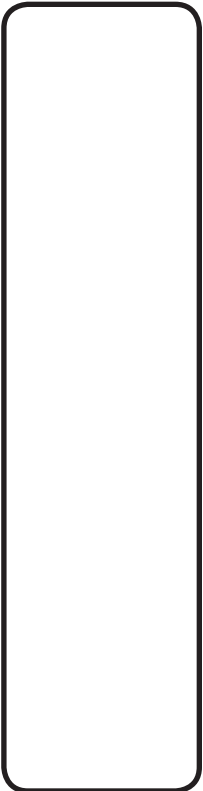

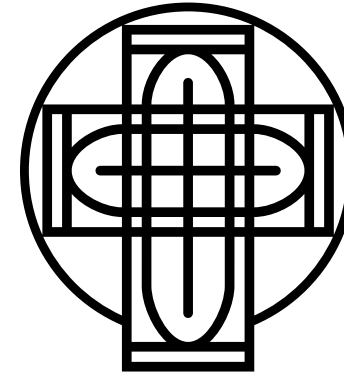

It is time, church family. It is time to be a church family in-person again. No, the pandemic hasn't ended entirely, but we have made the necessary progress to safely come back to church. This is a cause for celebration!!

Based on Church Council discussions, this is what it will look like when you arrive. On the organ side of the sanctuary, we have created a social distance section for all who wish to wear masks and keep their distance from others. If you choose to sit in this section, please wear your mask and remain 6 feet or more away from all others in that section. As a church that thrives on its gift of hospitality, we believe this a great way to be hospitable for any vulnerable or concerned person.

As for the rest of the sanctuary, we are adhering to the CDC's most recent recommendation. If you are vaccinated, we no longer ask you to wear a mask or sit socially distanced from others. True to Baptist form, we will respect your personal autonomy and discretion and will, therefore, not police or govern vaccinated versus unvaccinated.

Since our children remain unable to get vaccinated, the Church Council agrees that we should encourage masking and social distancing for all children and youth whenever they gather in classroom settings (Sunday School, Children's Church, etc.). We are following the local school system health guidelines to help determine our decisions on children.

Every Sunday is starting to feel more and more like church again. Thanks be to God! May we continue to be neighborly to each other and our community as we navigate this pandemic. May we, too, be mindful of the Spirit's movement as we envision and reimagine what it means to be God's church at First Baptist in Corbin.
