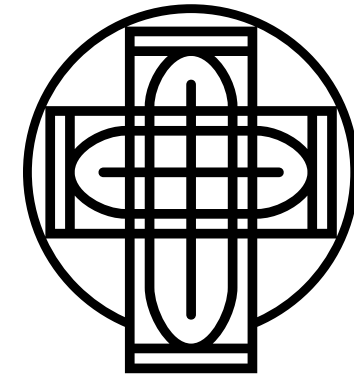

I'll sing my whole life long, and You will be my song. REFRAIN

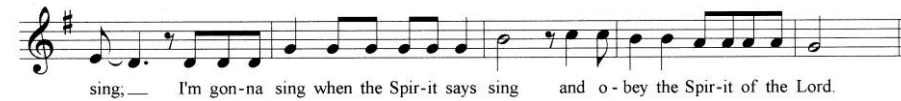
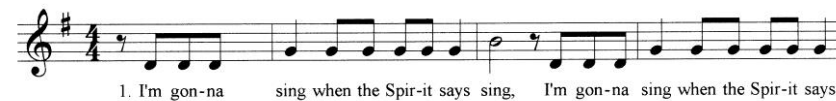
