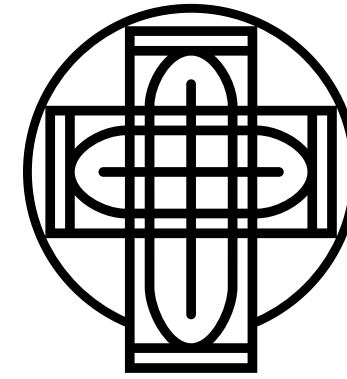


Due December 4th!

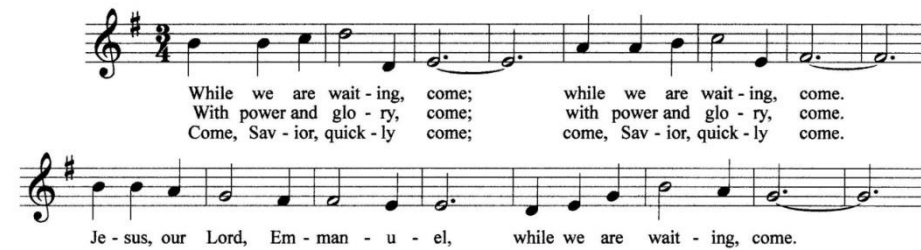

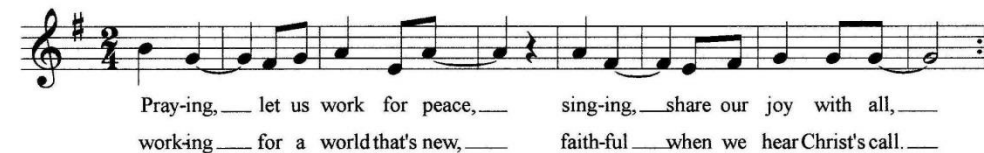
The Lord’s Prayer
