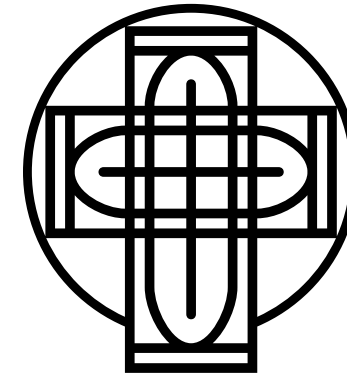

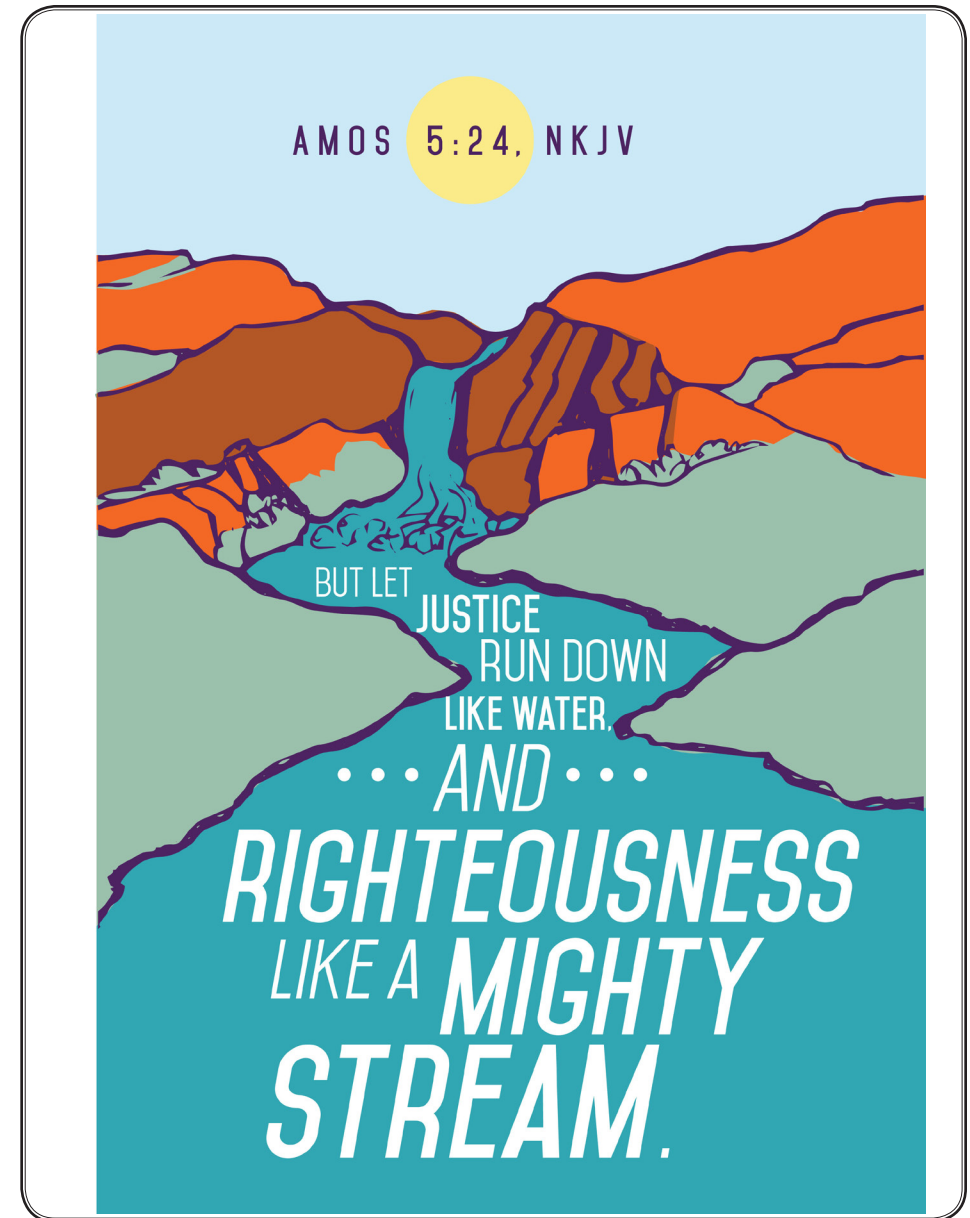

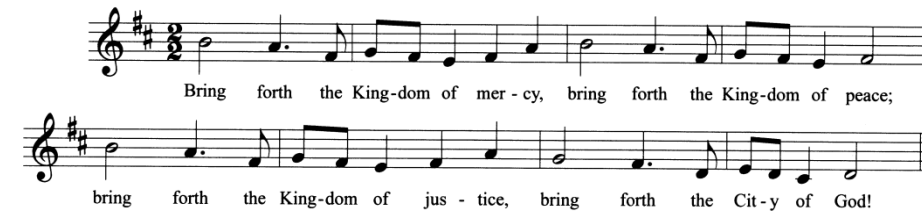
View the Present through the Promise
