College Student Ministry

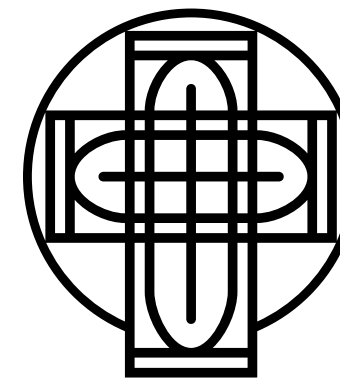
Would you like to be a part of helping FBC show love to our college

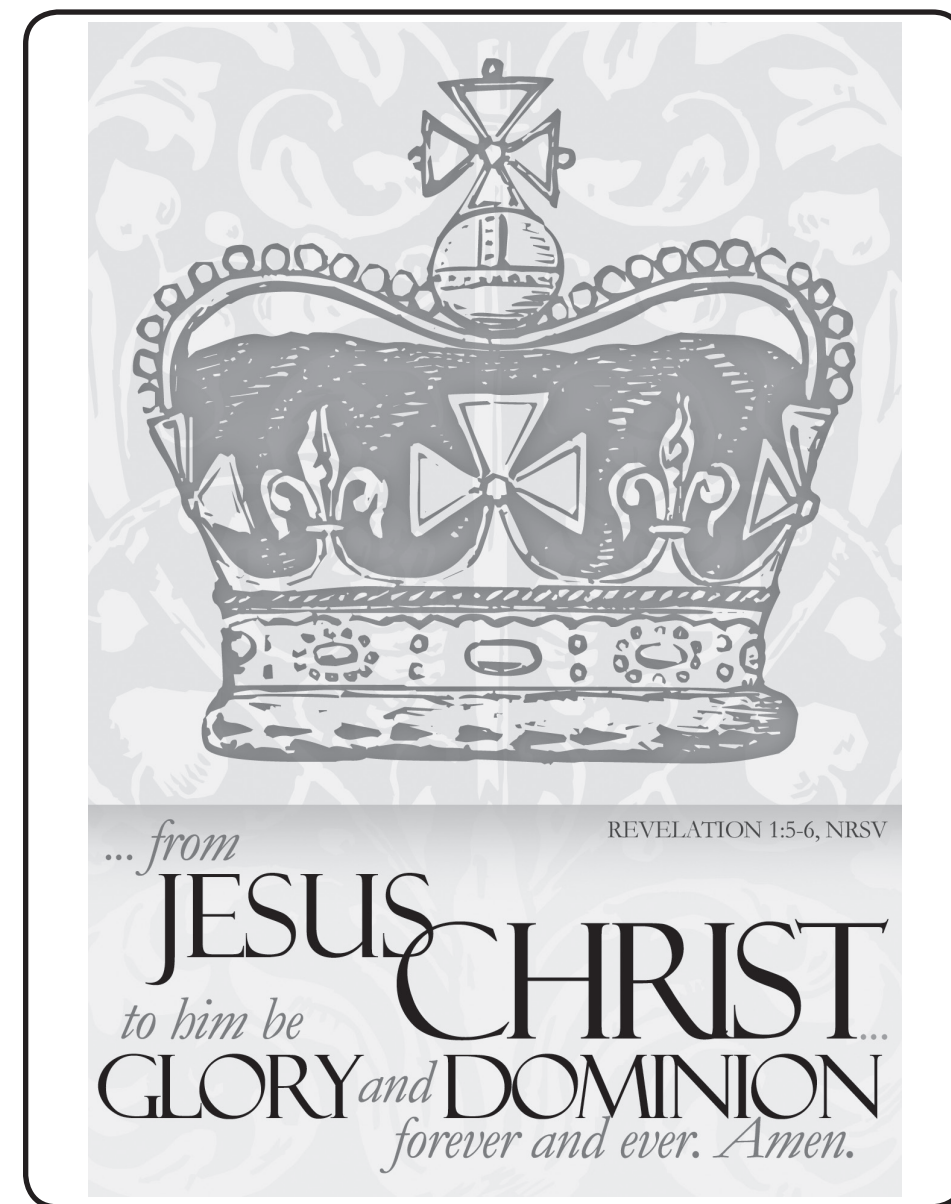
