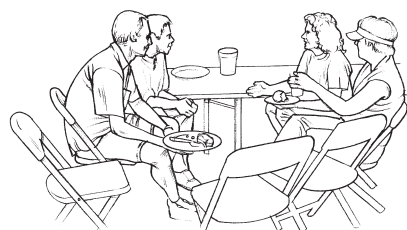

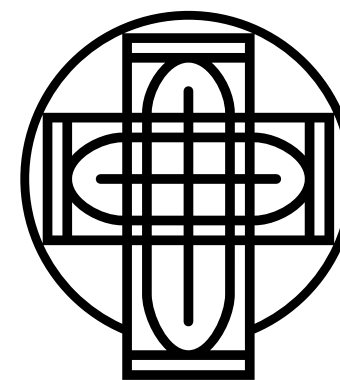


The end of our church year is upon us. It means a wonderful

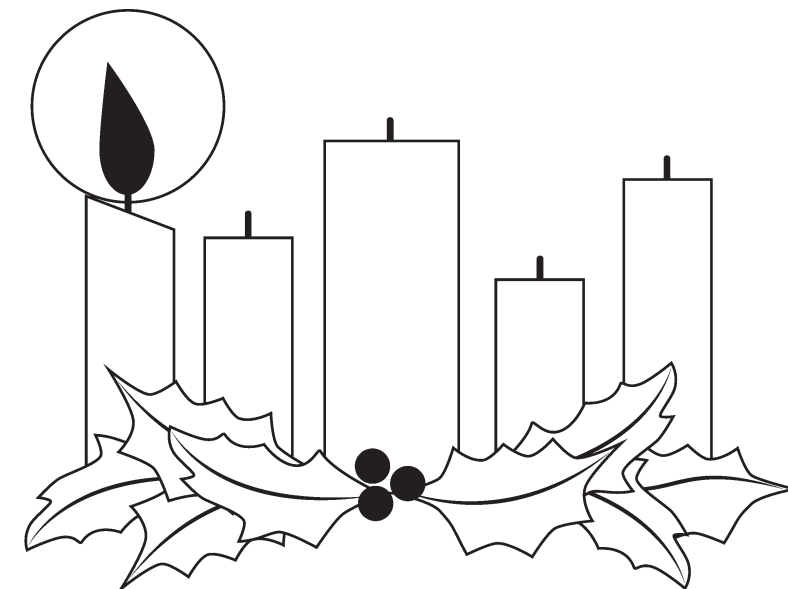
