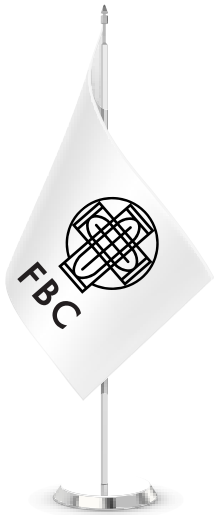

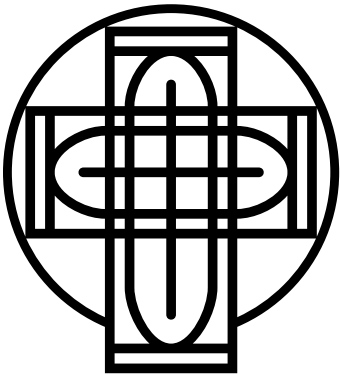
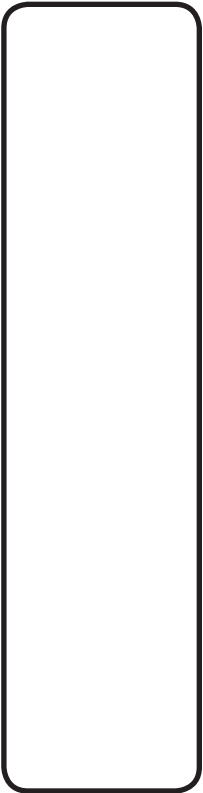

Can you provide soup or bread? A welcoming smile? Wash dishes? We need volunteers to drive the vans, serve on kitchen teams, and assist with intake and registration.

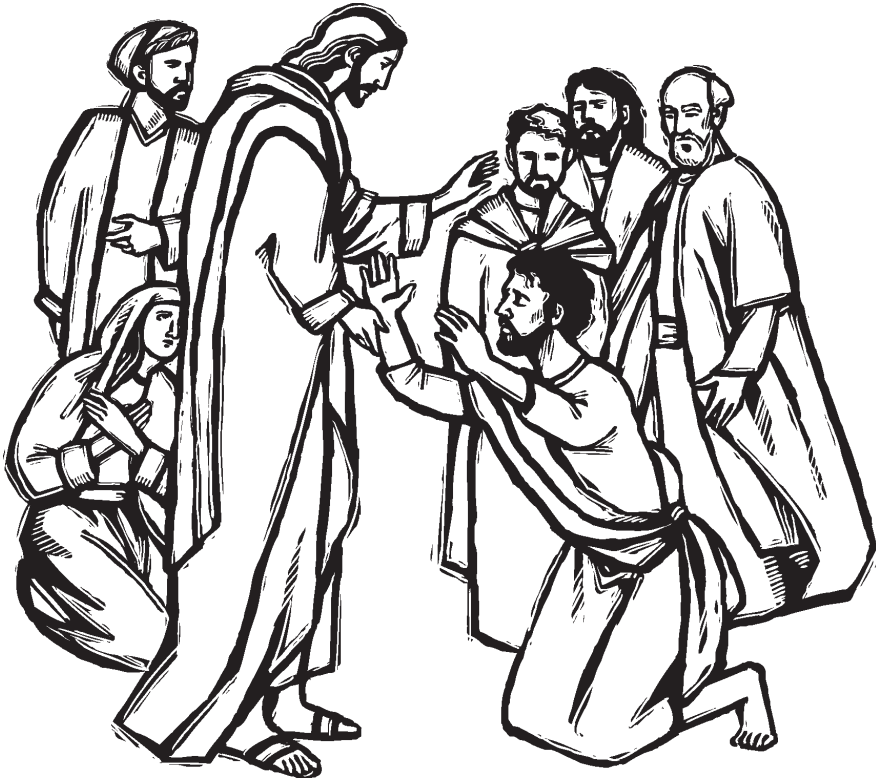
