Carl and Evelyn Brasher moved to Corbin in August 1962. They were invited to attend FBC by their close friends, Vernon and Laverna Asbridge, and, in November 1962, they and their two children joined First Baptist. Thus began their journey of service to our Lord through active involvement in First Baptist. They continued serving in various roles until their health prevented them from so doing.

Carl was a member of Sunday School and faithfully attended his class and, at times, acted as a substitute teacher. He enjoyed learning about the Bible by studying the Sunday School lessons and the fellowship promoted within the class. Over the years, he was a member of various committees and for several of those years was Treasurer. He greatly valued this opportunity, as well as, the resultant friendship developed with Mary Griffith. He instituted several changes to the financial reports to make them more transparent, some of which are still in use to this day.

Evelyn was involved in numerous activities during her membership. Her most cherished role was that of being a Sunday School teacher. She loved preparing her lesson plan, interacting with class members, and doing outreach. In her last years of active attendance, she would often reach out to ladies in similar circumstances as her, i.e., widowed and living alone. She wanted to keep them involved with the church and socially with one another. She wanted them to know that God had not forgotten them. She was often successful in this effort.

Carl and Evelyn left a rich legacy for their family to follow.

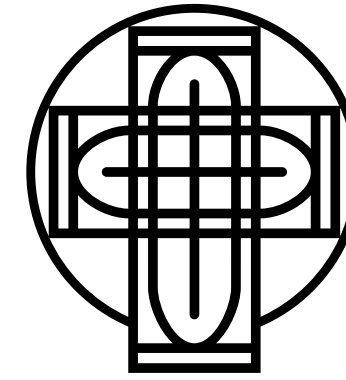

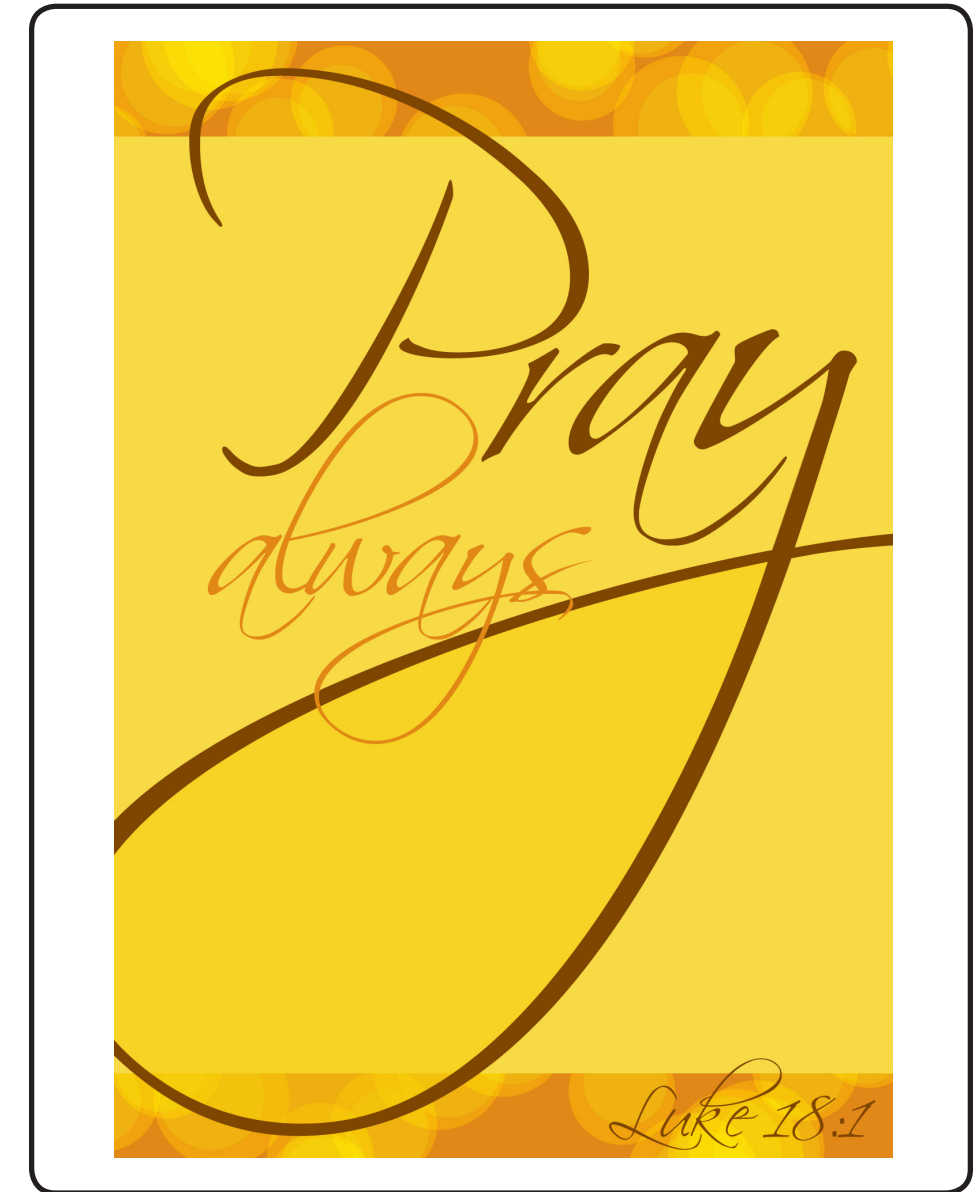
