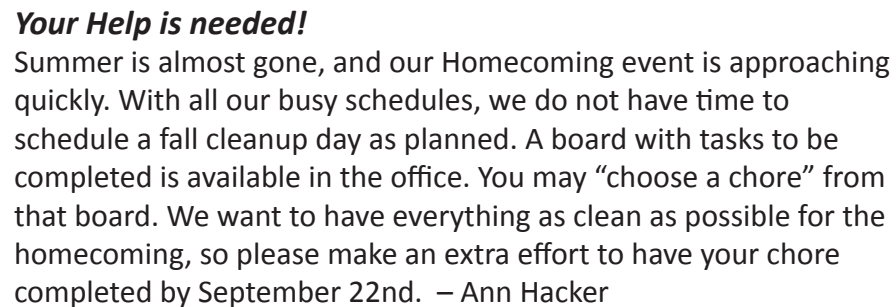
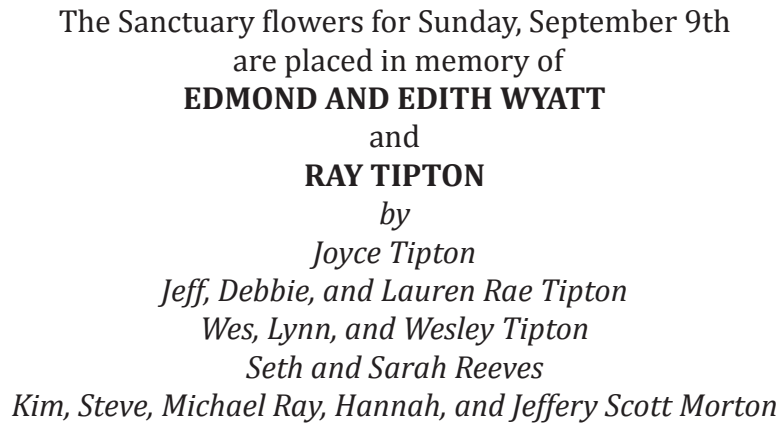
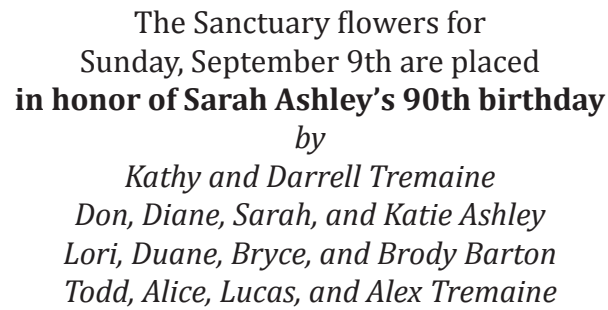
Here’s my pledge to you: each week I will come prepared with a Bible study that is both rich and relevant.
