Budget Update!

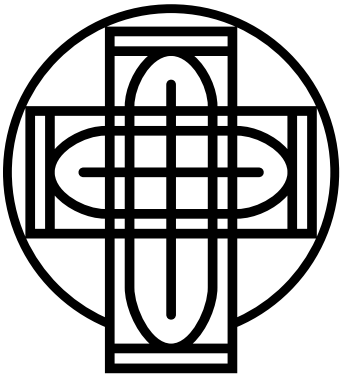
We have only 4 weeks before our fiscal year’s end. To meet our budget goal of \$528,010 we need \$87,005 by September 30th.
