The garden has had a fun and successful season this year. We had some wonderful times of companionship. We met some new friends who came by several times to talk and share. We hosted a missions team who planted some of our beautiful sunflowers. We worked with students from University of the Cumberlands, who got to experience a bit of the church's hospitality, gardening knowledge, and work on their volunteer hours.

Our beans were wonderful this year. We got the timing right and harvested lots of green beans in the early summer. Then the pole beans growing on the trellis came in during July and August.
