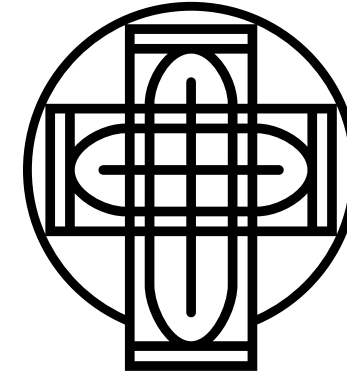

9 September 2020

In the 3rd Quarter Business Meeting, we

Financial Report:

The budget goal through the 3rd quarter was \$439,449.30. Income for the same period was \$390,225.94, while expenses were \$297,766.79.

Motions from the Personnel Committee were heard and approved to:

1. Expand the scope of the Associate Minister search to secure the best available candidate (full-time), whether it be Associate for Youth or Associate for Children. The remaining position would then be part-time.
2. Hire an intern to work as audio-visual-technical-production coordinator for the church – for a three-month trial period.
