The first Scriptural passage that altered the trajectory of my life in a very practical way was I Thessalonians 5:16-18, which reads, "Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances, for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you." It was my first year of seminary and I was feeling rather homesick. I was desperate for some divine wisdom to confirm the decision I had made to move to North Carolina for seminary.

This passage didn't confirm that decision. It was only confirmed after I put it into practice. Here, Paul frames the call to constant prayer within the lens of thankfulness. As a people of God, let us pause for a moment to be thankful.

For the 29 children that came to be with us last Wednesday, give thanks. For the 15 new/prospective members who attended our luncheon on Sunday, give thanks. For the forgiveness extended and received in response to God last Sunday, give thanks. For the gift of music and freedom to worship, give thanks. For the gathering of seekers who crave wisdom from studying Scripture, give thanks. For the committed sisters and brothers who join together for worship and service, give thanks. For the love of God we know through Christ Jesus the Son, give thanks. Give thanks in all circumstances.

In our thankfulness, may we also be reminded and encouraged to pray without ceasing. We are grateful for what God has done. We are praying for what God will do. And, in between, we are praying with thankfulness for what God is doing.
