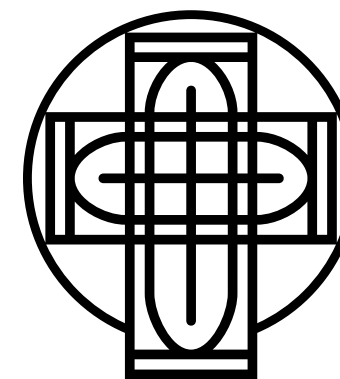

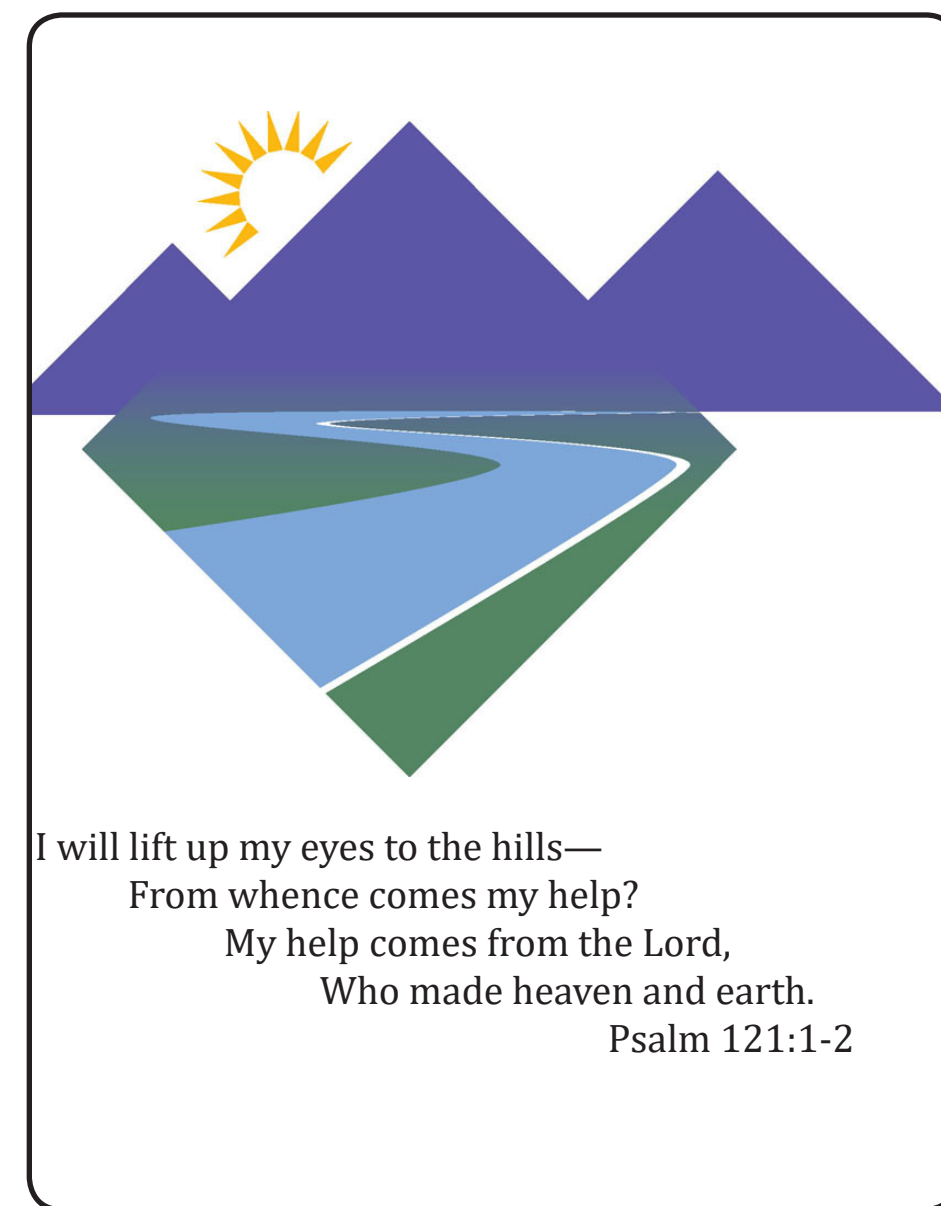
Budget Update!
