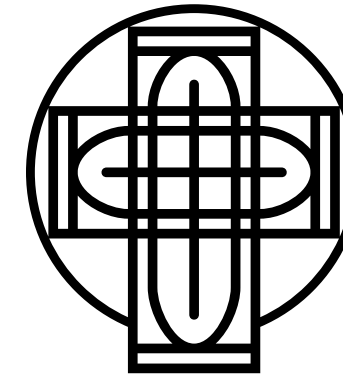
Budget Update!
