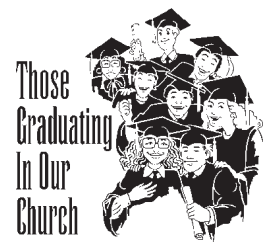


Chicken & Dumplings and A Silent Auction!!!

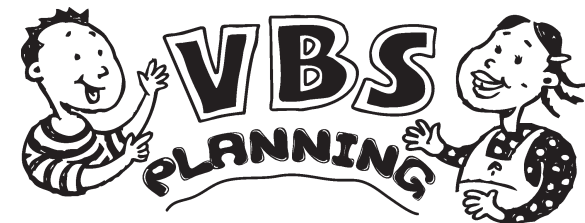

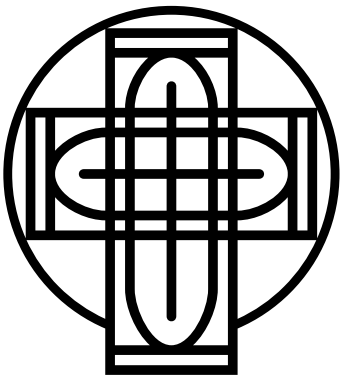

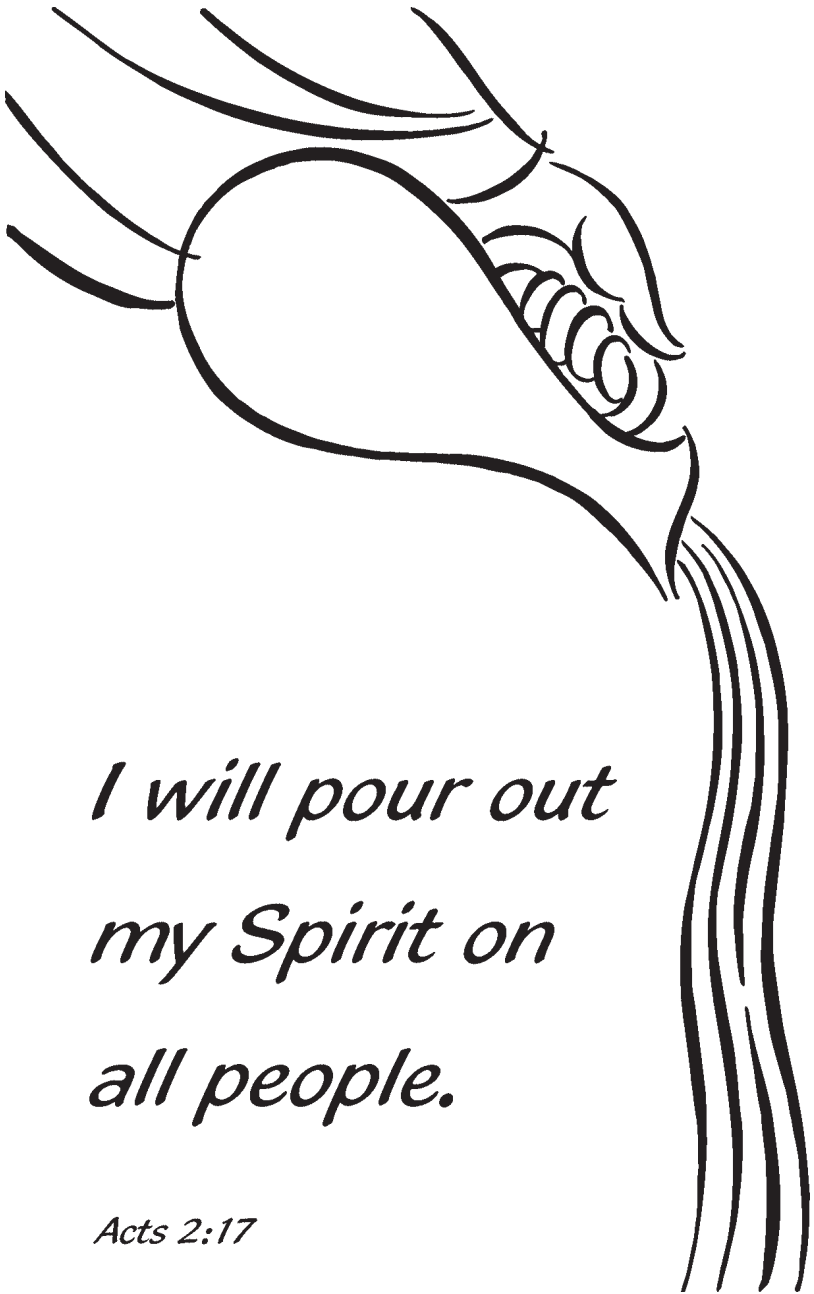

To my First Baptist Church Family,

The words “thank you” do not even begin to describe how grateful I am for your generous support, donations, and prayers throughout my recent mission trip to Belize. The supplies and funds that you donated made a significant difference in enabling my team to take close to \$50,000 worth of medical supplies, OTC products, and durable medical equipment with us to donate to people in and around Belize City. Providing this astounding number of supplies is an amazing feat in itself; but because of your assistance we were also able to provide health assessments to children and adults in nearby poverty-stricken villages, as well as live out and share the Gospel of Jesus with each site visit. Truly you and I, along with my team, were the hands and feet of Christ.

In the short span of eight days we were able to conduct two health fairs, visit three children’s homes, and serve as medical assistants in the local prison. At each stop we provided vital health screening tests, such as blood pressure and glucose testing. A group of Physician Assistants from Sullivan worked alongside us to provide much-needed eye- and ear exams. One of my team’s most extraordinary experiences was at the prison, where in one day we were able to see over 100 patients who normally would not have been seen by the (one) physician, due to the hierarchy ranking system. Here, we were able to treat a variety of illnesses: everything from the flu to high blood sugar, even appendicitis. Because of a recent outbreak of the flu the doctor had run out of Tylenol to combat the numerous high fevers, but with your donations we were able to fully restock the shelves!

Personally, one of my most memorable experiences was at a children’s home, where I played with a young girl about 6 years old. When we first met she was a bit shy, but with a little bit of persuasion from Easter eggs (and our mutual love of sweet treats) we became fast friends. Before long she was braiding my hair and teaching me some of her favorite school songs. One of the songs she sang that affected me was called “I Know Who I Am,” and it has quickly become a favorite of mine. I can vividly remember the pure love and hope she exuded as she sang, “We are a chosen generation, Called forth to show His excellence; All I require for life, God has given me; and I know who I am.”

It’s amazing to think that in such a short time we were able to accomplish so much and make a positive impact in the lives of many people. The truth, however, is that the people we worked with actually made a profound impact on me. Their love of life and strong spiritual faith in spite of their desperate circumstances were humbling and awe-inspiring. The people of Belize, as well as this journey, will forever hold a special place in my heart alongside my family of faith here at First Baptist Corbin. Thank you for this privilege.
